An essential aspect to ministry is understanding yourself and others so that you can minister effectively. A very effective tool in understanding personality is the Myers-Briggs personality evaluator. There is no right personality, and especially no “RUF personality.” Personality does not recommend or exclude you from ministry, but it does indicate how you will approach this job. Therefore it is an important part of our overall training process.
